There was a time a few years ago when this acclaimed vocalist could barely listen to music, much less sing. That was in the weeks following a life-threatening cardiac emergency called Aortic Dissection. It happened in February of 2007, coincidentally, Heart Health Awareness Month.

After a busy day which included volunteering, exercising, and a recording session, Patty was driving and felt a "burst" in her chest. ***"Not a twinge, more like a dagger in my heart."*** She was able to pull over and call 911 immediately. When the ambulance arrived, she was rushed to the hospital where they correctly ruled out a heart attack and determined she had an aortic dissection. This is the same cardiovascular event that took the life of actor, John Ritter.

Grateful for beating the odds of death, Patty's unwavering strength and love, has propelled her to share her experience with the hearts and minds of the world. Her compelling live presentation will fill your soul with music and passion for life, and remind us of the main reason we are all here: to ***"Live Your Gift"***.
